

Fall 2022 Peer Tutoring at Pitt Greensburg

The Learning Resources Center located in Millstein Library Building 250 offers free peer tutoring for a variety of subjects. This tutoring is for Pitt Greensburg students. Tutors are faculty recommended, trained, and paid Pitt Greensburg students. **To retain tutors and simplify the process, the LRC has made the following changes:**

How To Obtain Peer Tutoring

- **Peer Tutor Help Desks:**
 - Show up at a particular Help Desk during advertised hours (see Help Desk Hours handout)
 - These Help Desks will be clearly marked so they are easy to locate.
 - When you arrive, please give your name and the subject to the Help Desk Tutor.
 - If another student is already there, you may join in or wait until the other student is finished.
 - All efforts will be made to give you equal time.
 - At the end of each week, the Learning Center will notify your professor of your visit to the Help Desk.
 - Some tutors may devote all their hours to the Help Desk.
 - Other tutors **may** reserve some hours for weekly arrangements. Please see below.
- **To request a Help Desk for a subject we do not currently offer**, please email Dr. Lou Ann Sears at los3@pitt.edu.
- **Weekly Arranged Tutoring:**
 - If you are interested in your own hour to meet with this tutor each week, please ask the tutor if he or she has any hours to offer.
 - If so, please work out the day and the time with that tutor.
 - The tutor will have you fill out a Tutor Arrangement Form and will forward it to Dr. Sears.
 - Keeping track of this appointment will be your responsibility.
 - Standing up the tutor for the second time will result in discontinuation.
- **Please note that having a tutor is not a guarantee of success.**
