# **Responsibilities:**

- Attend training sessions, including a day of training on Friday, June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 (for SOAR) and training on August 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> 2025 (for Cornerstone/Seminar).
- Participate in summer 2025 Summer Orientation sessions and reside on campus from Wednesday evening until Friday afternoon on the following dates: June 25-27<sup>th</sup>, July 9-11<sup>th</sup>, and July 23-25<sup>th</sup>, 2025. (Some flexibility for special circumstances.)
- Participate in 2025 Welcome Week activities from Wednesday, August 20 through Sunday, August 24, 2025.
